DESCRIPTION

All students grades 6 through 8 are required to complete an Individual Learning Plan (ILP).

Policy Statement:

STATEMENT

South Laurel Middle School is dedicated to preparing all students for a successful transition to high school and then to post-secondary education, employment, or military service. With this goal in mind, all students grades 6 through 8 are required to complete an ILP. Each student will receive grade level instruction, activities, and guidance in developing an Individual Learning Plan (ILP). The ILP includes: 1.) career development and awareness of vocational studies 2.) availability and approval at least annually by the student, parent/guardian, and school official 3.) beginning in the 8th grade, learning goals set for the student based on academic and career interests 4.) identify required academic courses, electives, and extracurricular opportunities aligned to the student's postsecondary goals 5.) focus on career exploration and related postsecondary education and training 6.) include information about financial planning for postsecondary education.
